

PRIME

Your assigned primary care manager (PCM) provides most of your care.

- Your PCM may be a military or network provider.
- Call your PCM to make an appointment.
- Your PCM will give you referrals for care they can't provide to a doctor at a military hospital or clinic, or to a network provider.
- If you can't be referred to a military or network provider, you may be referred to a non-network provider.

SELECT

You can schedule an appointment with any TRICARE-authorized provider. An authorized provider is any individual, institution/organization, or supplier that is licensed by a state, accredited by national organization, or meets other standards of the medical community, and is certified to provide benefits under TRICARE. There are two types of TRICARE-authorized providers: Network and Non-Network., network or non-network.

You don't need a referral, but some services might require prior authorization from [Health Net](#).
